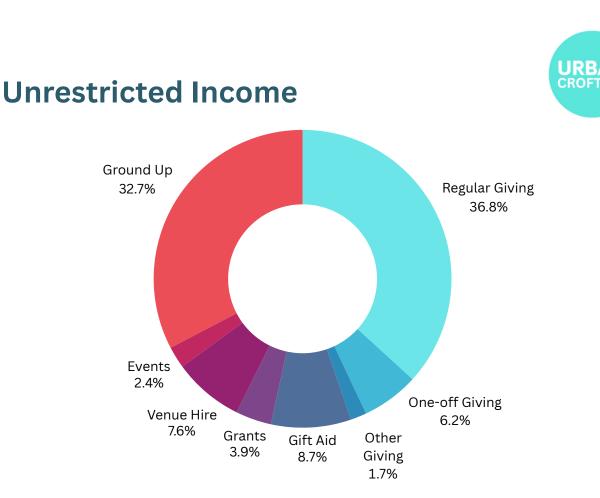
Income and Expenditure 2024

In 2024, we received a total of £194,889 in income. This included £176,679 in unrestricted income and £18,210 in restricted income.

Our total expenditure was £170,185, including £161,086 in unrestricted expenditure and £9,099 in restricted expenditure.



Note that "restricted" refers to money that has been received for a particular purpose and therefore can only be spent for that purpose. Whereas "unrestricted" means it's up to the Parochial Church Council (PCC) how the money is spent.



Donations are organised into three categories:

- Regular Giving also referred to as planned giving, including regular standing orders from our church community.
- One-off Giving any irregular donations from individuals.
- Other Giving including loose collections and legacy gifts.

Additional income is generated in three ways:

- Venue Hire rental income from hiring out the small hall and main church space.
- Events income from events, such as tickets.
- Ground Up income from our coffee shop during the day and at events.

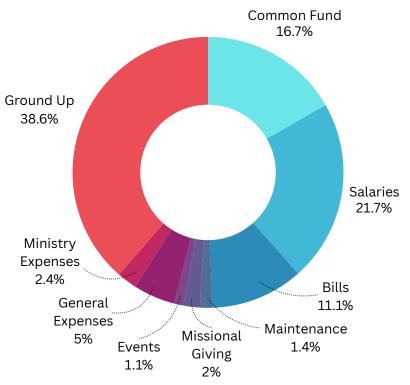
Other income includes:

- Gift Aid an additional 25% on donations when givers pay income tax.
- Grants specific grants that have been awarded from an organisation.

Unrestricted Expenditure



Costs of running the church and the building include:

- Common Fund donation to the Church in Wales to pay for clergy.
- Salaries wages for our part-time administrator and comms officer.
- Bills including utilities and insurances.
- Maintenance upkeep of the building.
- General Expenses including office expenses and purchasing equipment.
- Ministry Expenses costs of running our Sunday services and ministries.

Additional expenses include:

- Events to support the running of our events.
- Ground Up cost of running our coffee shop, including paying staff.
- Missional Giving donations to our mission partners.

Restricted Funds



"Restricted funds" refers to money that has been received for a particular purpose and therefore can only be spent for that purpose. Restricted funds might include specific grants or donations from individuals.

If you donate money to the church, you can request that your donations be included in a restricted fund. The PCC can keep that restricted fund in the accounts until it is needed. So, it doesn't need to be spent in that year but it can only be spent as part of that fund.

In 2024, Urban Crofters received £18,210 in restricted income. We then spent £9,099 of our restricted funds. Including the £5,690 of restricted funds left over from 2023, that means we finished 2024 with £14,801 in restricted funds.

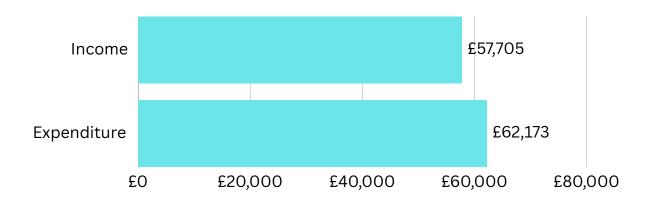

Ground Up

In 2024, income from Ground Up totalled £57,705, while expenditure came to £62,173. Income is generated through day-time opening hours as well as opening the café bar during events. Expenditure includes day-to-day expenses for running the coffee shop, staff salaries (part-time manager and baristas) and purchasing equipment.
